

In post-AI era, information and knowledge is easily attainable. However, in real world, how to use tools to solve complicate problems will be the key skill that separates human and machine. This course will focus on identifying a Global Issue the world is facing. Groupdiscussion with creative thinking approach will generate possible solutions. The course encourages creativity and different ideas. Through testing and implement solutions, students will apply this method in real-world-problems. This course also benefits them in team working, collaboration, leadership, and persuasive communication.

This course aims to foster habits of forming and assessing opinions using logical reasoning processes, teaching students how to think independently, analytically, and critically. The intention is that these skills will serve students throughout their student, professional, and personal lives, helping them excel in school exams, in interviews, and in their professional career.

Business Plan

This course aims to encourage critical thinking, creativity and reflection on the social purpose of organisations through group discussions and activities, culminating in the development of business plans through teamwork. This course gives you an opportunity to understand how businesses operate, adapt, and innovate within societal and technological contexts. By incorporating problem-solving exercises and discussions, it prepares youngsters not just to think about business in terms of profits and structures but as dynamic systems that require strategic decision-making and ethical considerations. This approach reflects the tutor's unique experience as both a professional teacher and business analyst in charity and renewable energy sectors.



Design Thinking - Lucy Aitchison

Design Thinking

Design thinking is a problem-solving approach that emphasizes empathy, creativity, and experimentation. A course in design thinking for students aim to help them develop these—skills and apply them to real-world problems. Students will learn about the principles and values of design thinking, including empathy, collaboration, and experimentation. Students will learn how to generate a large number of ideas quickly and effectively, using techniques such as brainstorming, mind mapping, and SCAMPER. A challenging project will be carried out for teams to compete, and user feedback will be rated. The best design is awarded.



Debate

Parliamentary-style debate and public speaking is an integral part of the Oxford experience and a crucial skill for aspiring young leaders. Students are coached in debating bychampion debaters from the Oxford Union, the world's most prestigious debating society. They are trained to form concrete arguments, and explain their points of view clearly and persuasively. This year debating will introduce new skills and topics such as social media's affect on youth, AI in education, science vs humanities, with roles for every student.



All students will be able to use the Point, Explanation, Example, Link (PEEL) model for their speech. A final debating competition will be host.

Location

Chengdu, 'Rong' for short, is located in the central part of Sichuan province. It is the provincial capital, sub-provincial city and national central city of Sichuan Province, as well as a science and technology center, business center, financial center and transportation and communication hub in southwest China. Chengdu is located in the western part of the Sichuan Basin and on the eastern edge of the Qinghai Tibetan Plateau.

It enjoys the subtropical monsoon climate and forms a vertical climatic zone with distinct Thermal differences, which brings extremely favorable conditions for the development of agriculture and tourism.

Dujiangyan created the Chengdu Plain into a rich 'Land of abundance' The rare animals include giant pandas, lesser pandas and golden snub nosed monkeys. Chengdu's delicacies are well known in China and in the whole world that's the reason why UNESCO awarded Chengdu the first gourmet capital in Asia.
